He is Founder and Chairman of the African Association for the Advancement of Management Education [AAME] an organisation that promotes a re-evaluation, rethinking, reconceptualization and recontextualization of the theory, practice and teaching of management and leadership in Africa in the context of African experiences, culture and conditions. AAME also promotes intra and inter African business, networking and investments. In 2007 he became Executive Director of St Martin's Business School a position he relinquished in mid 2010. He sits on the ZimTrade board and is a Commissioner at the Consumer Protection Commission. He is currently the National

Principal Director for the Zimbabwe African National Union [Patriotic Front].

He has held board positions at Elligo Plastics, Focus Security, was Chairman of R&F Intercontinental Holdings, Chairman Zimbabwe Industrial Hemp Trust, Board member Harare Quarry and Chair Human Resources and Nominations Committee. He also sits on the ZimTrade Board and is a Commissioner at the Consumer Protection Commission. Dr Gomo is an international trade lawyer. He is a holder of several degrees including Ph. D International Business, Master of International Law and the World Economy, LLM in International Legal Studies.

The Advisory Board, would, inter alia, advice on programs and organizational planning, and advocacy for public policy to protect private sector businesses.
